Dear Superintendent Swenson:

I am pleased to report that the Board of the Massachusetts School Building Authority (the "MSBA") has voted to approve the Bridgewater-Raynham Regional School District (the "District"), as part of its invitation for Feasibility Study, to proceed into Schematic Design to replace the existing George H. Mitchell Elementary School with a new facility on the existing site (the "proposed project").

It is my understanding that the District anticipates seeking community approval for this proposed project in September 2019. Therefore, it is critical that the District, in conjunction with its Owner's Project Manager and Designer, submit a schedule to the MSBA as soon as possible, which should include: the work plan to complete all of the required documentation for presentation to the MSBA's Board of Directors at a future Board meeting; the date of the Town Council Meeting at which the proposed project will be considered; and the anticipated design and construction schedule.

We will be contacting you soon to discuss these next steps in more detail, but in the meantime, I wanted to share with you the Board's vote to approve the Bridgewater-Raynham Regional School District to proceed into Schematic Design to replace the existing George H. Mitchell Elementary School with a new facility on the existing site.


